# Terms of Reference for selection of District Resource Persons (DRP) for implementation of PMFME Scheme in Odisha

## I. QUALIFICATIONS:

The District Resource Person (DRP) should have the following qualifications:

- a. Diploma / degree in Food Technology / Food Engineering from reputed State / National / International universities / Institute.
- b. 3-5 years experience in providing consultancy services to food processing industries for technology up-gradation, new product development, quality assurance, food safety management etc.
- c. In absence of candidates in the above two criteria, persons with experience in food processing industries, banking, DPR preparation and training will be considered.

## II. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

To provide handholding support to individual units and groups for preparation of DPR, taking bank loan, support for obtaining necessary registration and licenses including food standards of FSSAI, Udyog Aadhaar, GST etc. The empanelment will be initially for one year and will be renewed from year to year based on satisfactory performance and coterminous with the scheme.

## III. PAYMENT:

Payment would be made on the basis of each beneficiary supported by them after sanction of loan to them by the bank. Payment to each DRP would be Rs. 20,000/- per bank loan sanctioned. 50% of the payment would be made after sanction of bank loan and remaining 50% after the unit takes GST & Udyog Aadhar registration, takes standard compliance of FSSAI, implement the project and is given training.

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**


**Subject: Relaxation in qualifications of the District Resource Persons (DRPs) under the PMFME scheme**

This in with reference to the OM- FM-11/4/2020-DS(FME) dated 24<sup>th</sup> December regarding the qualifications for engagement of DRPs under the PMFME scheme. It has been noticed that few States/ UTs are requesting for relaxation in the DRP qualifications as they are not able to find suitable candidates with requisite qualification.

2. In the light of the above, it is informed that if required, the State/ UT could relax the qualifications of the DRPs mentioned in OM- FM-11/4/2020-DS(FME) dated 24<sup>th</sup> December. As per the revised qualification, a candidate having Bachelor's or equivalent degree in any field with relevant knowledge/experience in DPR preparation would be eligible to apply for DRP. However, it should be ensured by the State Nodal Department/Agency (SNA), that the candidate should not be a Government employee.

3. Moreover, if required, the State/ UT may hire additional manpower with expertise in DPR preparation to assist the DRPs in providing handholding support to beneficiaries. Out of the prescribed payment of Rs. 20,000/- to DRPs, a payment up to Rs.5000/- per application could be fixed for this additional manpower.
